

## RESOLUTION 2026-16

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASTATULA, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027, BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2026, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2027; PROVIDING AND ANNOUNCING THE NAME OF THE TAXING AUTHORITY, THE ROLLED-BACK MILLAGE RATE, THE PERCENTAGE INCREASE OVER THE ROLLED-BACK MILLAGE RATE, AND THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes s. 200.065 requires the adoption of the millage rate by separate vote prior to adoption of the annual budget; and

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes s. 200.065 requires that prior to adoption of the millage-levy ordinance, the following be publicly announced: the name of the taxing authority, the rolled-back millage rate, the percentage increase over the rolled-back millage rate, and the millage rate to be levied; and

**WHEREAS**, in no event may the millage adopted exceed the millage rate tentatively adopted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASTATULA, FLORIDA:**

1. The millage rate Resolution is hereby considered by separate vote prior to the budget Resolution.
2. The name of the taxing authority is the Town of Astatula.
3. The rolled-back millage rate for fiscal year 2027 is 6.5521.
4. The fiscal year 2027 proposed millage rate is 0.00% higher than the rolled-back rate.
5. The millage rate to be levied for fiscal year 2027 shall be 6.5521 mills per \$1,000 of taxable value.
6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
