EMERGENCY BUSINESS

REQUEST FOR NATIONAL STORM RECOVERY, LLC TO USE THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 24200 CR 561, ASTATULA AS A TEMPORARY SITE FOR THE COLLECTION OF STORM DEBRIS FROM HURRICANE DORIAN.

Vice-Mayor Mack asked Clerk Wells to give an overview of the agenda item before the Board. Clerk Wells stated that the site shown above is a Planned Unit Development District where the specified uses did not include the storage of storm debris unless special permission was granted by Council. Governor DeSantis has issued an Executive Order declaring a State of Emergency for Hurricane Dorian and the Town Attorney was happy that the decision to be taken by the Board was an emergency measure.

Vice-Mayor Mack wanted to have a start date which was set as Tuesday September 3, 2019. Clerk Wells said that the motion had been cleared by the attorney and should be read as stated adding the start date.

MOTION by Councilwoman Kobera to grant special permission under State of Emergency Executive Order 19-189, for National Storm Recovery, LLC to use the property located at 24200 CR 561, Astatula as a temporary site for the collection of storm debris from hurricane Dorian. This permission is for a period of 90 days beginning Tuesday September 3, 2019, after which any extension must be approved by Council; SECONDED by Councilwoman Sikkema


