**FINAL BUDGET HEARING
THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 29, 2022
TOWN HALL**

Having been duly advertised as required by law, Mayor Mitchell Mack called the Tentative Budget Hearing to order at 7:06 pm. He gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

This public hearing is for the purpose of announcing the percentage by which the millage rate differs from the rolled-back rate; and for Council to adopt a final millage rate by Resolution. Council will also adopt the final budget for Fiscal Year 2022-23 by fund department.

**RESOLUTION 2022-25 - DETERMINING THE AMOUNT AND FIXING THE RATE OF
AD VALOREM TAXATION**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASTATULA, FLORIDA,
ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE OF 7.5000 MILLS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 FOR
THE TOWN OF ASTATULA, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Mayor Mack read the resolution title and announced the following information as required by Florida Statutes:

- The Taxing Authority is the Town of Astatula
- The Rolled-Back Rate is 7.0855 mills
- The Percentage over the Rolled-Back Rate is 5.85 percent
- The Millage Rate to be Levied is 7.5000 mills

At this point the Mayor opened the meeting for public comment on this issue only; there being no residents present he closed public comment.

It was then opened for Council discussion. There being no questions, the Mayor called for a motion to approve Resolution 2022-25.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ASTATULA, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A FINAL BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF ASTATULA, FLORIDA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mayor Mack read the resolution title and announced the following information as required by Florida Statutes:

The Final Budget for the Town of Astatula for Fiscal Year 2022-23 to be adopted by Fund Department is as follows:

- General Fund – In the amount of \$1,486,867.00
- Transportation Fund – In the amount of \$86,330.00
- Infrastructure Fund – In the amount of \$198,000.00
- Enterprise (Utility) Fund – In the amount of \$123,039.00
- TOTAL ALL FUNDS - \$1,894,236.00

At this point the Mayor opened the meeting for public comment on this issue only; there being none he closed public comment.

It was then opened for Council discussion. There being none, Mayor Mack requested a motion to approve Resolution 2022-26.


There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 7:10 pm.
