Davis Quiros asked if residents can have more than one recycling tote. He also asked on which holidays the trash was picked up and those that it was not. The Clerk said that he would get clarification from GFL.

CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION 2023-16 TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL COST OF COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE FOR EACH RESIDENTIAL DWELLING TO \$250.50 PER UNIT FOR FY 2023-24.

A motion to read by title only was made by Councilman Teeters; seconded by Councilwoman Sikkema and unanimously approved. The Mayor read the title and Section 1 of the resolution. He opened the floor for public comment; there being none, he closed public comment and requested a motion to approve.

MOTION by Councilwoman Sikkema to approve Resolution 2023-16 to increase the annual cost of collection of Solid Waste for each residential dwelling to \$250.50 per unit for FY 2023-24; SECONDED by Councilwoman Issartel
